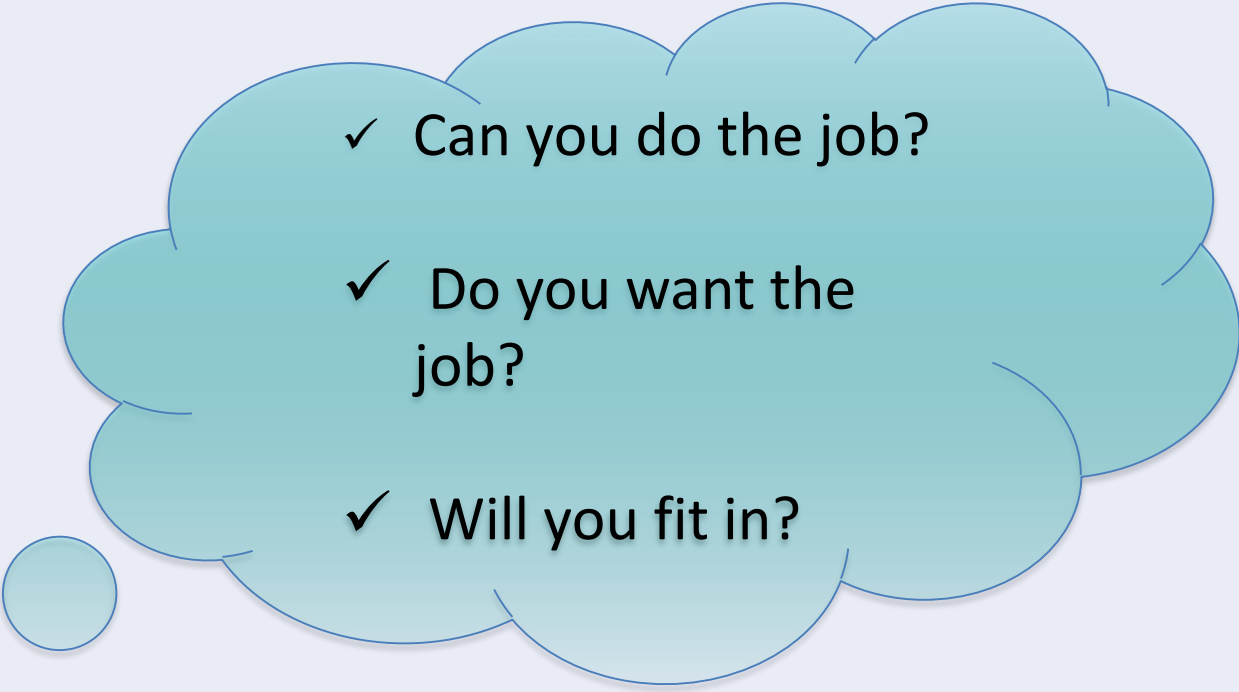

Preparation = Confidence

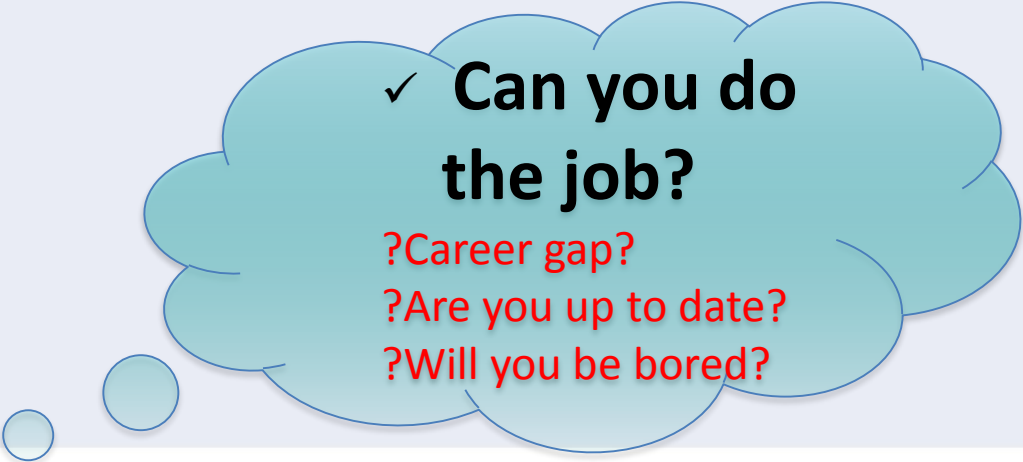
The Interviewer's 3 questions!

- 
- ✓ Can you do the job?
 - ✓ Do you want the job?
 - ✓ Will you fit in?

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1. Can you do the job?

- Tell me about yourself – work not personal life
- What have you achieved in the last 3 years that will help you in this role?
- How do you manage your time?



✓ **Can you do the job?**

?Career gap?

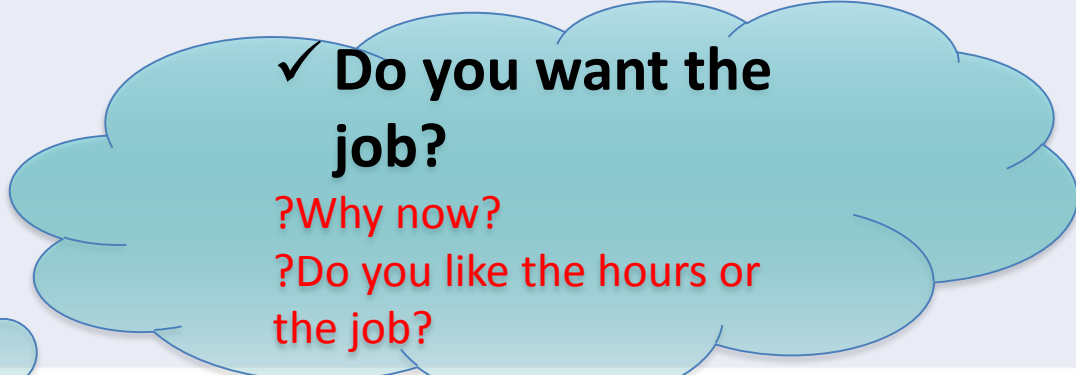
?Are you up to date?

?Will you be bored?

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2. Do you want the job?

- What do you know about our organisation?
- Why do you want to work for us?
- Why this role?
- Why are you in the job market now?



✓ **Do you want the job?**

?Why now?

?Do you like the hours or the job?

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3. Will you fit in?

- Tell me about a time when you worked well in a team?
- Can you work late and come in on Sundays on occasion?
- If you were an animal what would you be?



✓ **Will you fit in?**

?Will you help out
when we're busy?

?Will work come first
when needed?

- **T**ask
- **A**ction
- **R**esult

- **Review.....**
- **Plan.....**
- **Practise.....**

= Confidence

Nailing it!

- Go prepared & confident
- Be ready to give examples related to the job
- Prepare questions for them (about them not you)
- Leave the flexible working question until job offer
- Say thank you and follow up
- Keep up your job search
- **Turn the interview into a job offer!**
